What is Electrical Installation?

Electrical Installation is an integral part of the construction industry. Electrical Installation Engineers, commonly known as 'Electricians' or 'Sparkies' are responsible for installing and maintaining the electrical and power systems to domestic homes, commercial and business premises. This involves installing a variety of accessories and equipment, then wiring them up to an electrical supply, testing the circuit to make sure it is safe and then maintaining it. There are also many associated jobs and pathways that can be followed into electrical installation, maintenance and service sectors.
