CIPS LEVEL 4 **REQUIREMENTS**

This is the highest entry point onto our diploma qualifications. A minimum of at least two A Levels (or international equivalent) or a CIPS Level 3 Advanced Certificate qualification is required. Alternatively, you will need a minimum of two years' relevant experience in a business environment.
